

## WONDER OF LIVING FAMILY ENRICHMENT PROGRAM

### *ESSENTIAL BOOKING INFORMATION – please read carefully*

#### **COSTS (2018)**

- **Parent Only Session** - \$450
- **Parent/Child Session** - \$375

#### **COMBINED BOOKINGS FOR SMALL SCHOOLS**

Two or more small schools may make a combined booking. In this case a further \$150 per extra school per session is charged.

#### **DISCOUNT OFFERS**

- Second and further Parent/Child session held in same calendar year discounted by \$25 per session.
- Purchase *Wonder of Living* DVD series (3 DVDs & Teacher's Guide on CD-ROM) and receive 10% discount off the first presentation held in same calendar year as purchase. Teacher's Guide contains completely prepared units of work for follow-up on all themes and topics raised in the DVD series.

#### **REGIONAL SCHOOLS – time/travel surcharges**

- For one session, a time/travel surcharge of \$100 applies on top of the \$375 session fee. Total \$475
- For two sessions on the one night, no travel/time surcharge applies. No discounts apply to the second session (cost \$375 plus \$375, total cost \$750).

#### **DEPOSIT**

- Bookings must be confirmed by forwarding a \$75 deposit to Open Doors via EFT payment to Open Doors Cheque Account BSB 083337 a/c 529993647.
- The deposit is not refundable if a session is cancelled any later than 2 weeks before the booked date.
- Where booked dates are spread across more than one term, the deposit will be deducted from the invoice for the final presentation.

#### **SESSION NUMBERS**

- **Parent Only seminar** - no restriction on numbers.
- **Parent/Child session** - we prefer to work with a maximum of 50 families per session. This ensures efficient running of the session and a better experience for participants. Where more than 50 families are likely to attend a session it is possible to split the group and offer two sessions on the one evening, commencing around 6pm, and with a 15-minute change-over break in between.
- **Please note that if session numbers exceed the maximum limit, an extra charge to cover the cost of extra handout materials may apply.**

#### **SESSION INFORMATION**

**Parent Only Information Sessions** (*Recommended*) are designed to give parents the opportunity to preview material, ask questions and consider the importance of their role in this aspect of their child's healthy development. Even parents who do not intend bringing their child to the Parent/Child nights are encouraged to attend for their own education and encouragement.

**Parent/Child Sessions** (*full details in the 'Outline Family Night Sessions' document*)

- Session A (1 hour; development and birth of baby; for Years 3-6)
- Session B (1 hour; includes how a baby begins; for Years 4-6)
- Session C (75 mins; puberty; for Years 5/6)
- Session D (75 mins; puberty info plus how a baby begins; for Years 5/6)

Note that – Parent/Child sessions are based around the *Wonder of Living* DVD series and are designed to deliver information sequentially from year 3 to year 6. If the school community has not undertaken any sexuality education for some time, older year levels may be invited to attend the earlier sessions so as to cover foundational information about babies, birth, the human body, sexual intercourse, etc, prior to attending a puberty session.

- When offering a combined Yr 5/6 puberty session, *we recommend* schools offer this yearly rather than every second year so that Yr 5 parents can decide on their child’s readiness.

- All sessions contain an element of resilience skill building to cope with ups and downs in life.

## BOOKING OPTIONS

**Parent Only information session** - can be held earlier in year to free up the calendar.

**Parent/Child sessions** can be offered in various ways across the year, depending on your needs and situation. As part of your decision you may need to consider readiness of each year level cohort, continuity of information you want to provide, previous learning and when/how that was delivered, parent expectations and preferences.

Here are some examples with suggested times -

### EXAMPLE - 3 Parent/Child sessions held over 3 evenings

<b>Evening 1</b>	7 – 8 pm	<b>Session A open to years 3 - 6</b>
<b>Evening 2</b>	7 – 8 pm	<b>Session B open to years 4 - 6</b>
<b>Evening 3</b>	7- 8.15 pm	<b>Session C open to years 5 - 6</b>

### EXAMPLE - 3 Parent/Child sessions held over 2 evenings

<b>Evening 1</b>	6 -7pm	<b>Session A open to years 3 - 6</b> <i>Year 3s leave after the first hour</i> <i>5 - 10 minute break</i>
	7.10 – 7.45pm	<b>Years 4 - 6 stay on for shortened Session B</b>
<b>Evening 2</b>	7 – 8.15pm	<b>Session C open to years 5 - 6</b>

### EXAMPLE - 2 Parent/Child sessions held on 1 evening

<b>Evening 1</b>	6 – 7pm	<b>Session A for year 3/4</b> <i>15 minute crossover break</i>
	7.15 – 8.30pm	<b>Session D for Years 5 - 6</b>

### EXAMPLE - 3 Parent/Child sessions held on 1 evening

<b>Evening 1</b>	5.30 – 6.30pm	<b>Session A for year 3 or 3/4</b> <i>15 minute crossover break</i>
	6.45 – 7.45pm	<b>Session B for Year 4 or 4/5</b> <i>15 minute crossover break</i>
	8 – 9.15pm	<b>Session C for Years 6 or 5/6</b>

**Feel free to contact us and discuss your needs.**

**SET UP AND EQUIPMENT - please allocate a staff member to ensure the following:**

- chairs set up so families are sitting together
- pencils for each family for activity sheets
- table at front for presenter (preferably not too low)
- side table for resources and handouts
- data projector etc with audio, plus staff member present who is competent with the school equipment
- presenter will bring own laptop or can use the school set-up if that is preferable
- presenter will arrive approximately 20 minutes beforehand to set up
